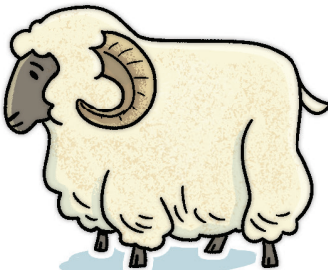
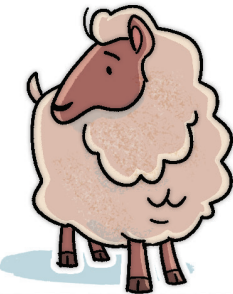
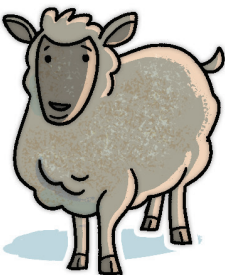
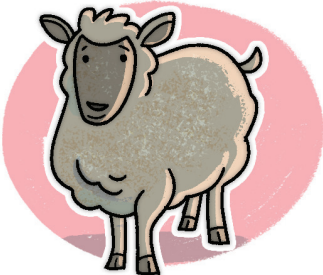
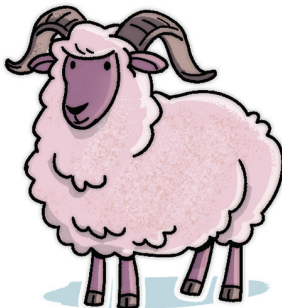
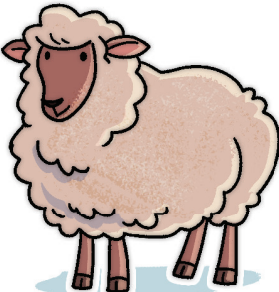
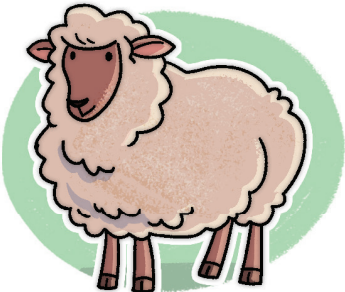
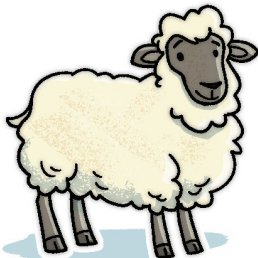
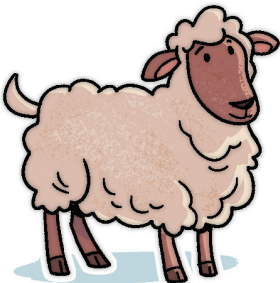
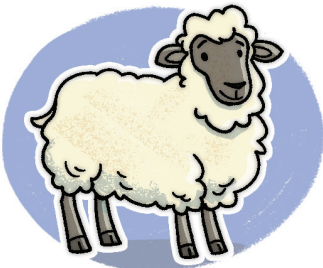


Pairing Lambs
